## Gender perspective on green jobs in the Nordic region in new publication

During the years 2020-2022, NIKK has produced reports on topics such as the labor market and gendered study choices as well as sustainable development. NIKK has now gathered parts of the results from the reports in a publication that highlights how issues of gendered educational choices and gender-segregated labor market, norms on skills and distribution of care work are related to the transition to green jobs.

The publication highlights and discusses the challenges of the green transition based on five thematic approaches:

- Interventions to break down gender segregation
- Gender labelling of technology and of sustainability
- Academic norms and workplace culture and social sustainability
- Welfare systems and the significance of place
