The Danish Environmental Protection Agency Surveys on chemical substances in consumer products

The Danish Environmental Protection Agency – Unit of Chemicals works systematically to identify the chemical substances in consumer products that are used daily.

Products include products such as toys, children's items, hobby products, cosmetics, jewelry, textiles, furniture, and household chemicals.

Objective of surveys:

- To gain knowledge about which harmful chemical substances are used in consumer products
- To assess the risk of using consumer products containing harmful (unregulated) chemical substances
- To reduce the risk: Input for regulation. Advise consumers and retailers on purchasing safer products. Collaboration and knowledge sharing with other countries

Since 2001 nearly 200 surveys have been completed
